
SSA #51 is managed by CBA.




9 CTA Bus Routes Serve the Area

History + Culture

Chatham has experienced many transformations due to decades of physical and demographic changes. With a former residency of Swedish, German, and Irish descent groups in the 1920s, the population shifted to a Black middle-class community by the 1970s and continues to be so today.

Several buildings with elegant architecture styles such as Classical, Gothic, Spanish, Renaissance Sullivanesque, and Prairie remain today converted from their initial purpose.

The people and businesses that make up Chatham have formed a tight-knit community where older generations help new entrepreneurs.

CBA is one of 51 recipients nationwide to receive a \$1 million grant from the U.S. Small Business administration to start the Chatham Business Association Navigator Program. The pilot program is intended to provide additional financial assistance and resources to assist underserved business communities.




